Urban-15 announces the fourth annual Josiah Youth Media Festival on July 8, 9, and 10, 2010. Over 103 Films have been received from young filmmakers from here in Texas, other states and other countries including our first entry from Iceland.

The three-day event will take place at the URBAN-15 Studio in San Antonio, Texas. In addition to screenings there will be opportunities for critiques and discussions at The Media Now free student workshops. A grand prize of a \$500 line of credit with B & H Photo & Video will be awarded, as well as additional prizes for various categories.

In 2006, Josiah Miles Neundorf, a talented media artist from San Antonio, Texas, passed away as a result of Osteosarcoma, a cancer of the bone. In his short twenty years with us, Josiah expanded the lives of those who knew him through his brilliance, his joy and his determination to create outstanding works in the midst of the pain and physical ravages from this disease.

In honor of this artist, his parents, Marcus and Nancy Neundorf with the URBAN-15 Group are proud to announce the continuation of the Josiah Youth Media Festival, an annual event designed to showcase outstanding works by young film, video and media artists.

Screenings of films will take place Thursday, Friday, and Saturday evenings, beginning at 8 p.m.

The Media Now student workshop will be presented on Saturday, July 10, 10 a.m. to 4 p.m., with box lunches provided. The event is offered free of charge to students ages 21 and younger; but, as placement is limited, advance registration is required. Please contact URBAN-15 by phone or email to sign up.

Tickets for the screenings are \$7 for general admission, \$4 for students, military, artists and seniors.
